Timeline

- September 19-27 Informal interviews held
- September 24th Officer Election: 3-5 grades present as voting body
- September 23-25 Class Representative Elections held in classrooms
- September 30th First ASB Meeting

Positions & Distribution of Scores

President, Vice-President and Secretary Officer Positions (5th grade only): Completed candidate form (20%), Interview (30%), and Grades 3-5 Student Vote (50%)

Class Representatives (2 reps per 4th and 5th grade classrooms): Completed candidate form (20%), Interview (30%) and Classroom Student Vote (50%)

Cabinet Member (4th and 5th grade): Completed candidate form (50%) and Interview (50%)

3rd Grade Guests: Each meeting will have rotating 3rd grade guests joining the meetings so they can see what ASB is all about and hopefully build interest and excitement to be involved in ASB the following year!
